

Italian poet Leopardi's "Operette morali" to feature in NY



(AGI) - New York, Oct 31 - New York City will experience Giacomo Leopardi's "Operette morali" over two nights at the Auditorium Theatre, in an event dedicated to the show created by Turin's Teatro Stabile to mark the 150th anniversary of Italy's unity. The show in the Teatro Stabile, under artistic director Mario Martone, received the prestigious Premio Ubu in Italy, and was performed in major Italian theatres and at the Theatre de la Ville in Paris. Four prominent Italian actors will take the stage: Renato Carpentieri, Roberto De Francesco, Giovanni Ludeno, and Paola Rota. The showing in New York was organised by the Scuola Italiana in collaboration with the Italian Institute of Culture in New York, during the year of Italian culture in the U.S.. It also coincides with the publication of Leopardi's Zibaldone in English. (AGI)
